Distant lightning present below 20 MHz during the post-sunset tail-off of daytime terrestrial propagation.

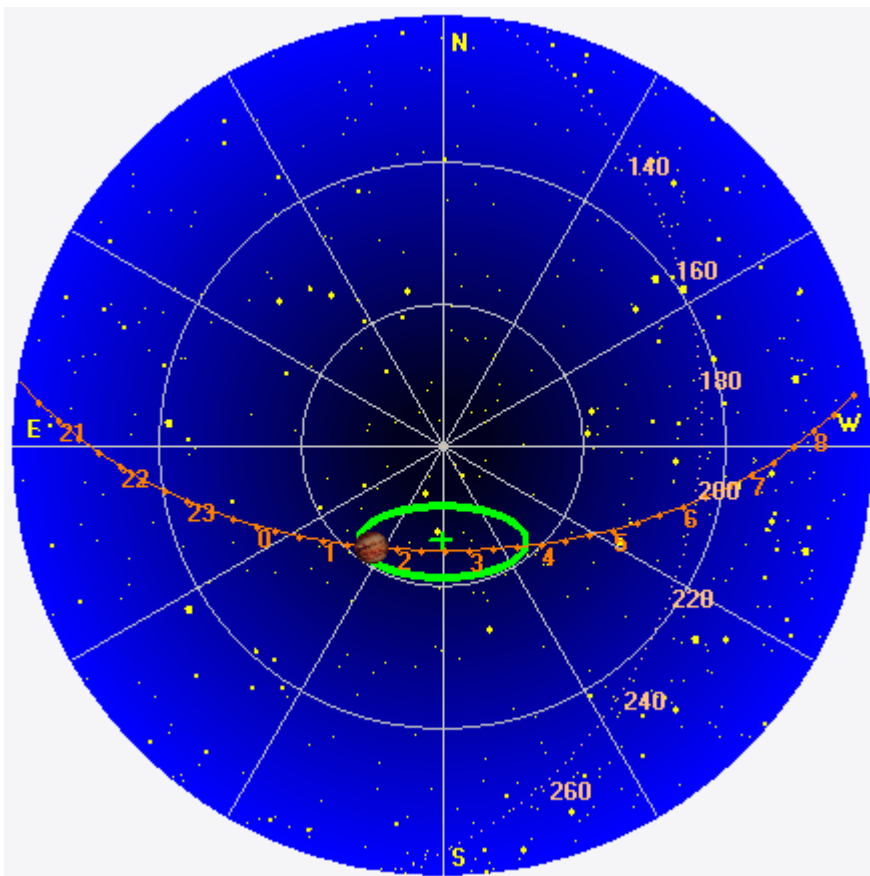
Jupiter was -16° to -14° off axis.

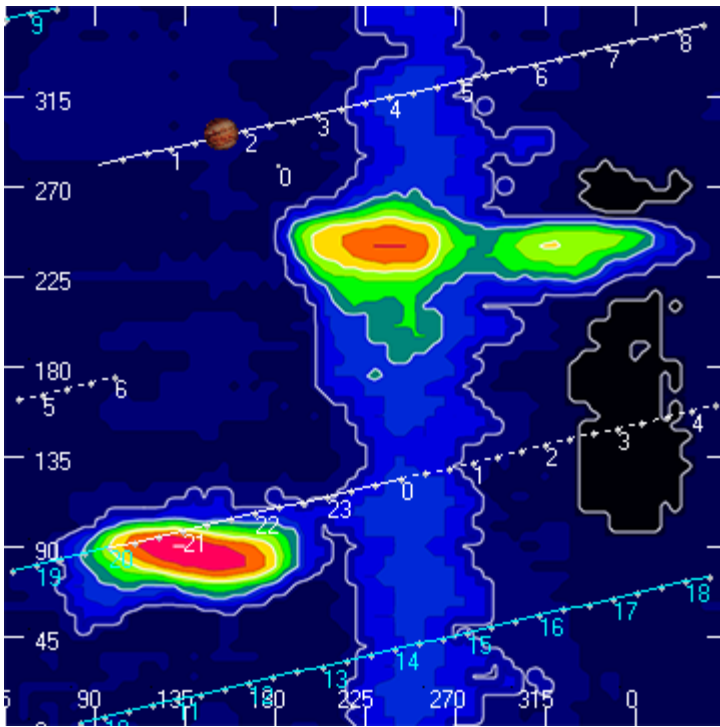
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 133° .

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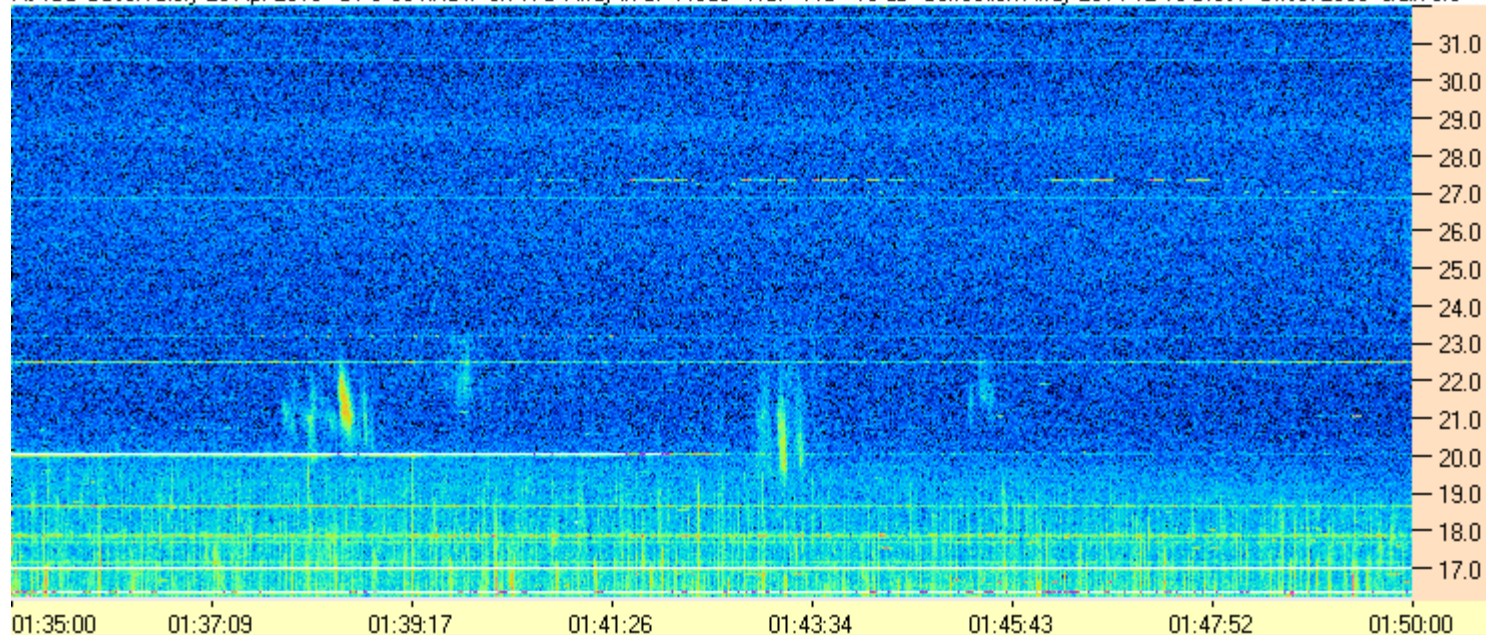

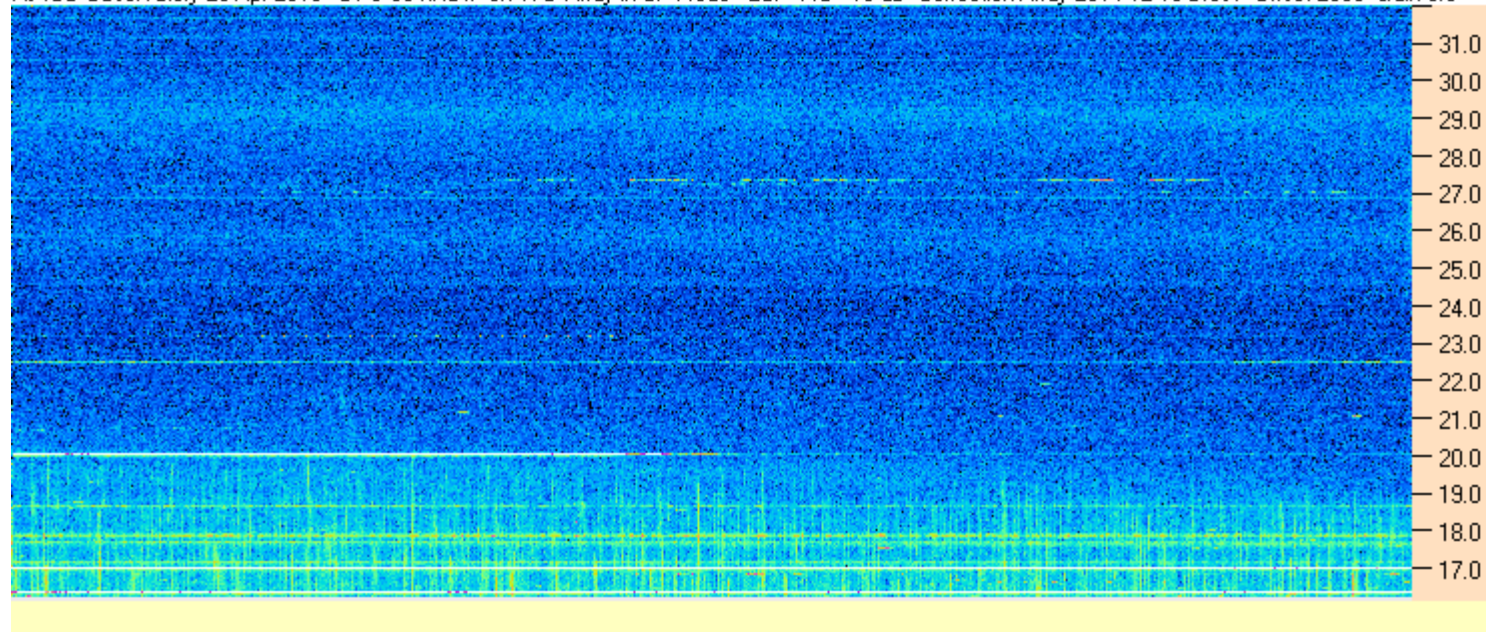




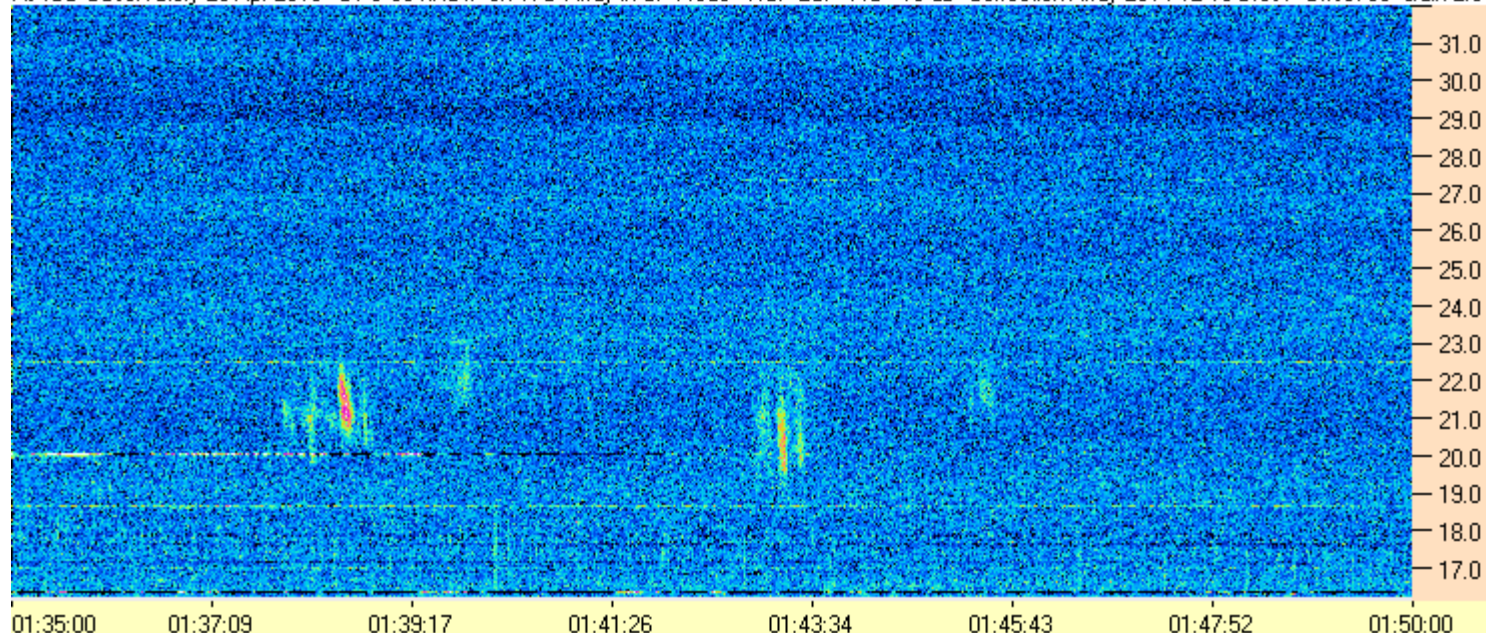
