RCP dominant L bursting 0138-0422 UTC from 16 to 30 MHz, negative drift emission envelopes.

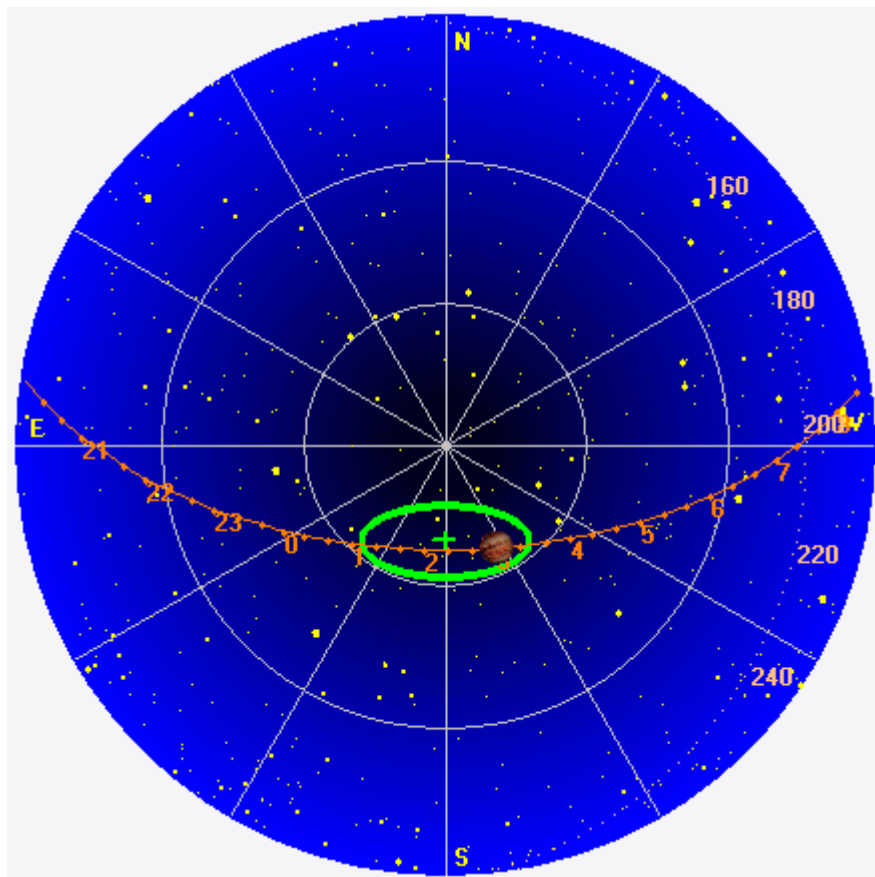
Jupiter was -10° to $+30^\circ$ off axis.

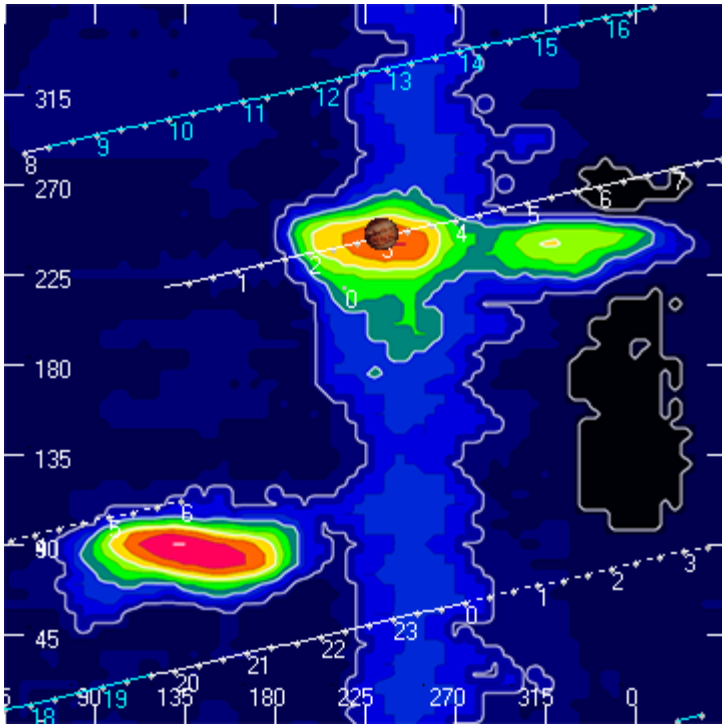
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 128° .

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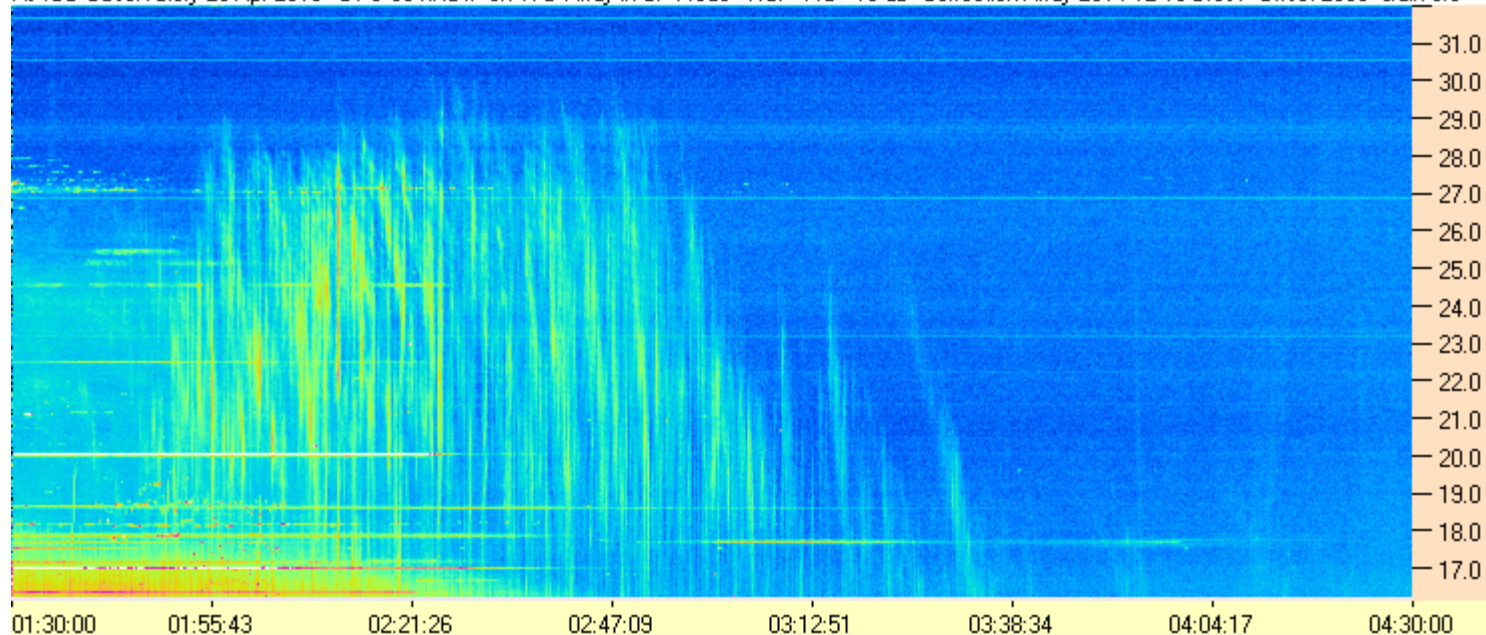

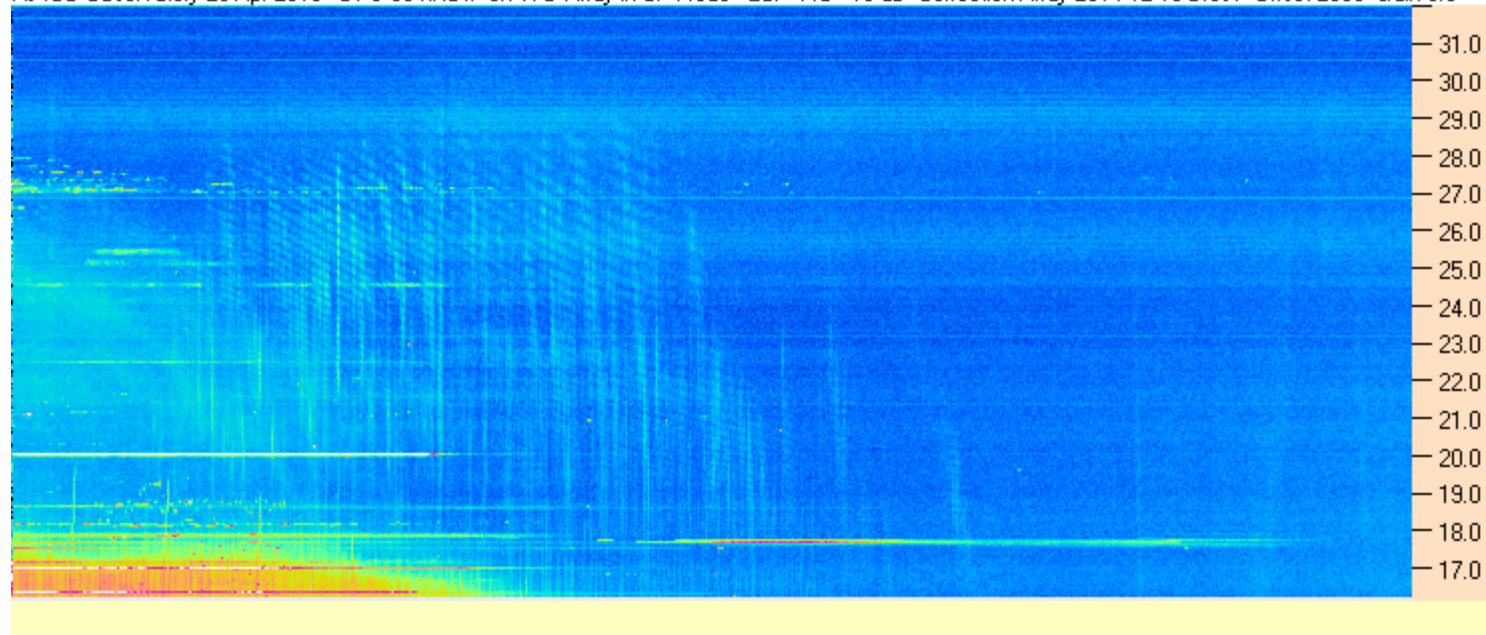




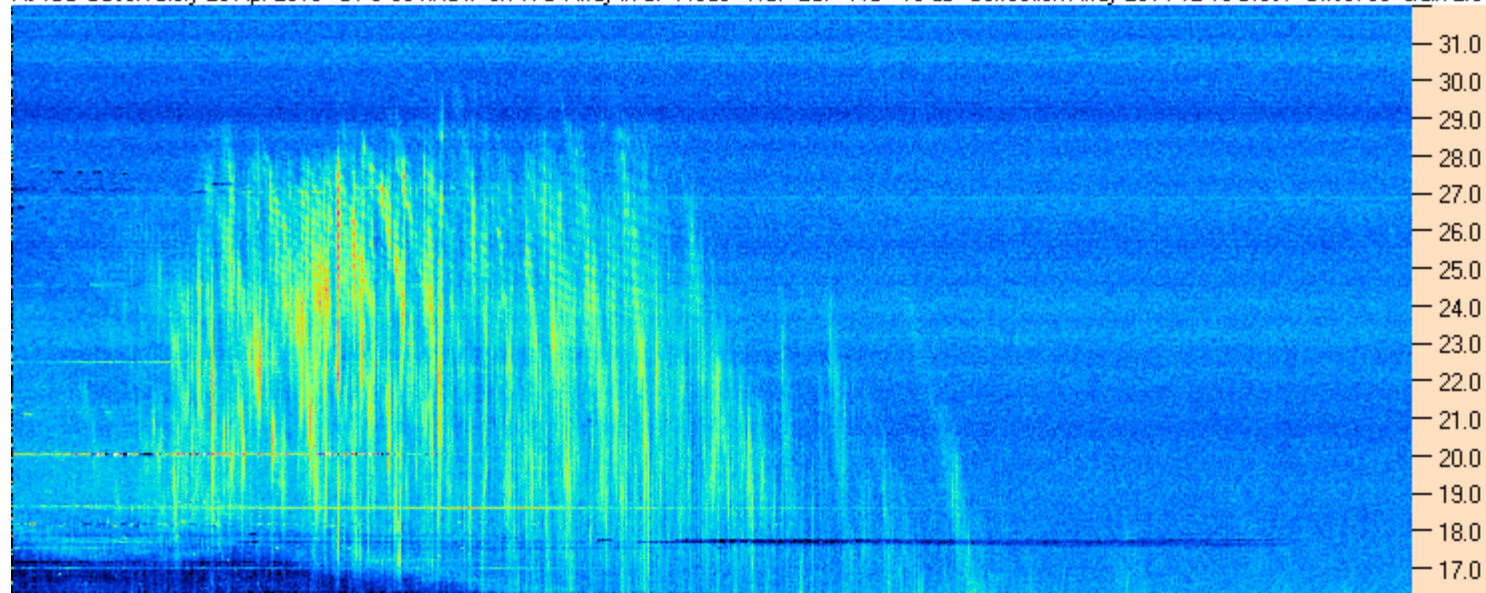
