RCP dominant L bursting 0051-0247 UTC from 16 to 25 MHz, positive drift emission envelopes.


Strip chart pretty useless due to the Jovian emission not being much stronger than the band noise.

Jupiter was -20° to +9° off axis.


Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 126°.
