Strip chart pretty useless due to the Jovian emission not being much stronger than the band noise.

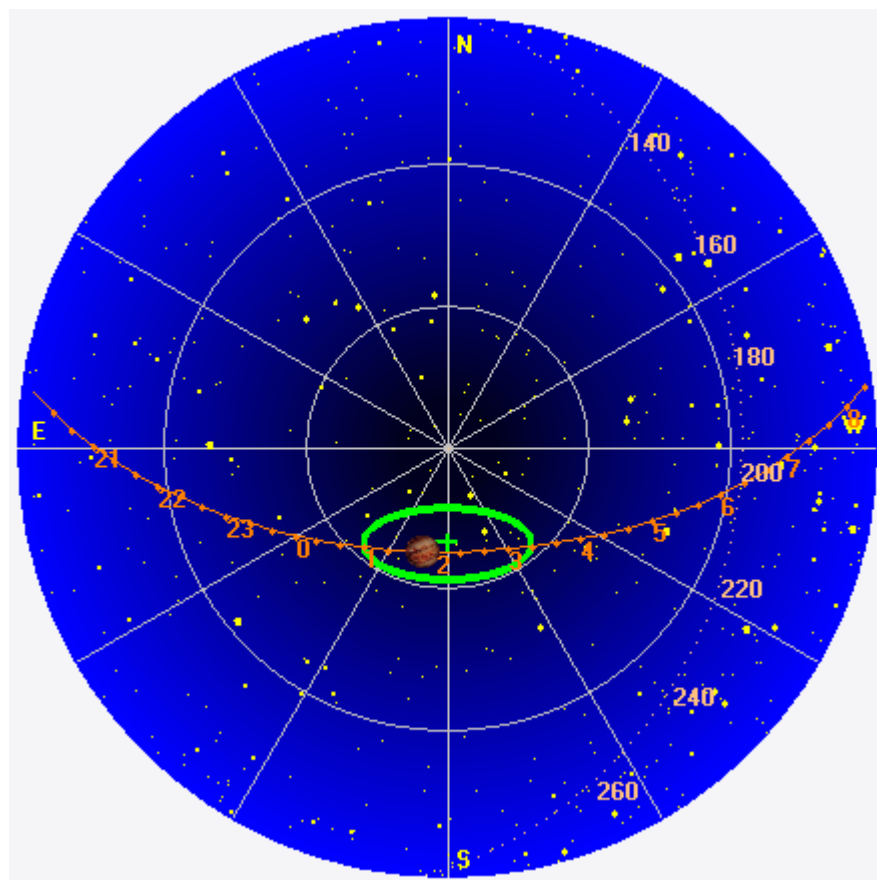
Jupiter was -20° to $+9^\circ$ off axis.

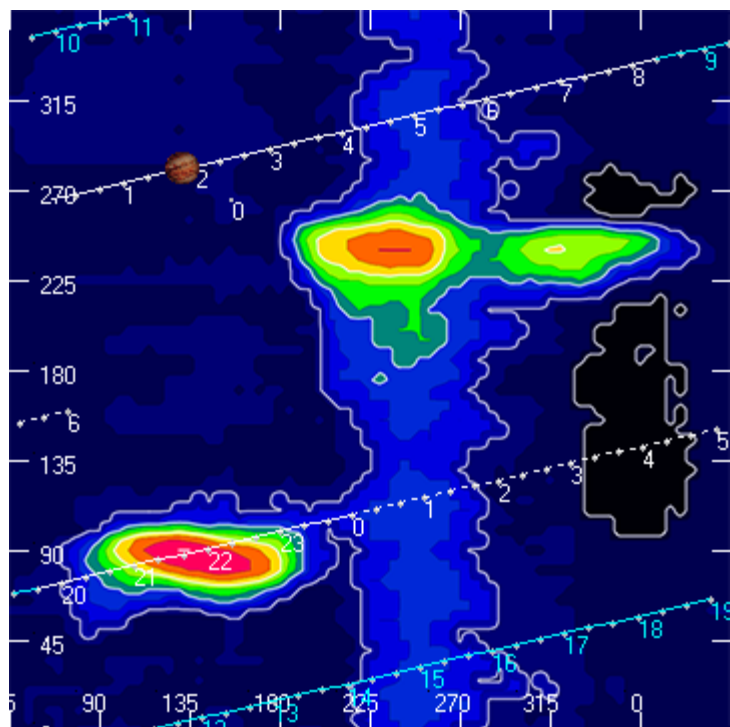
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 126° .

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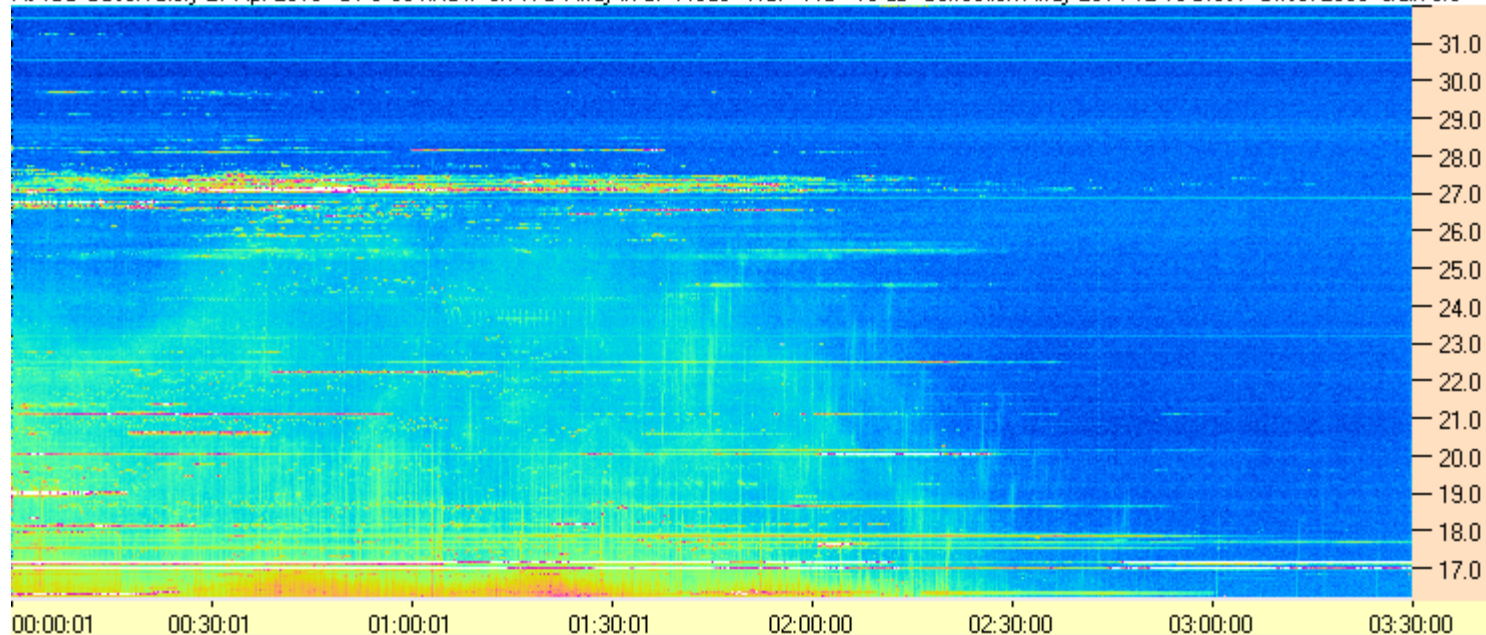

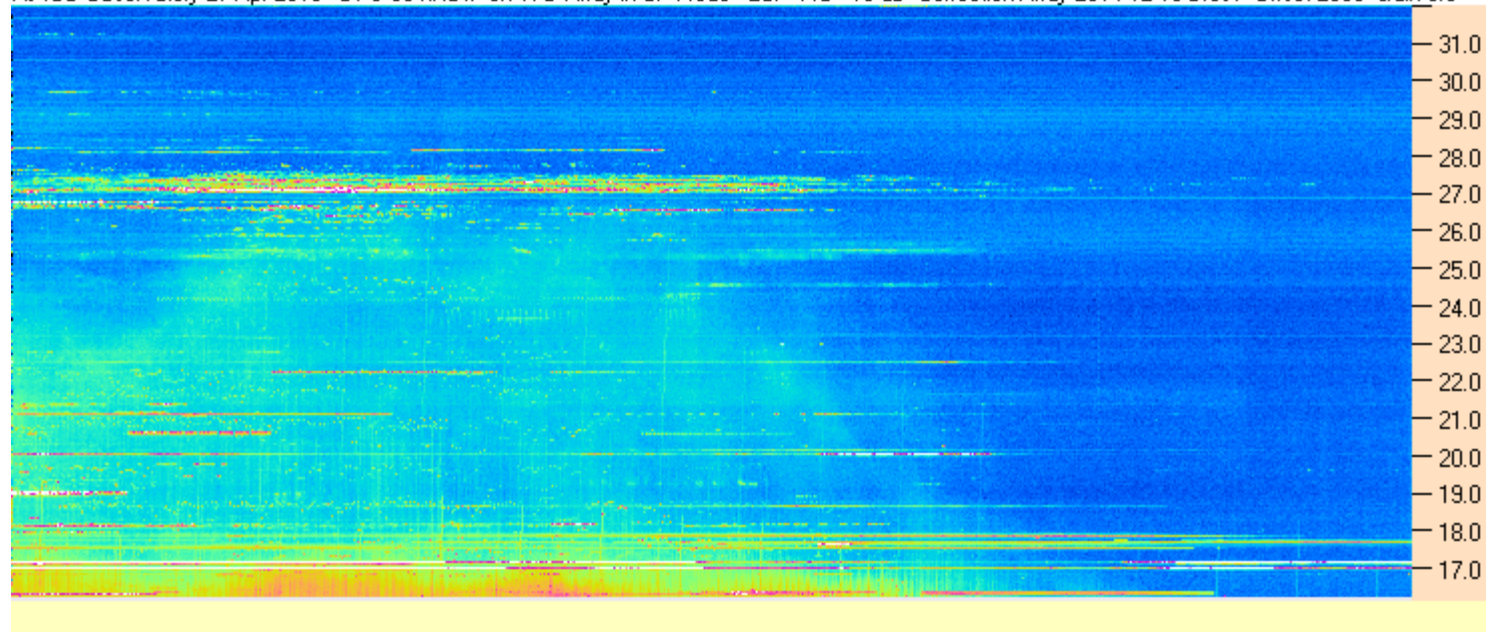




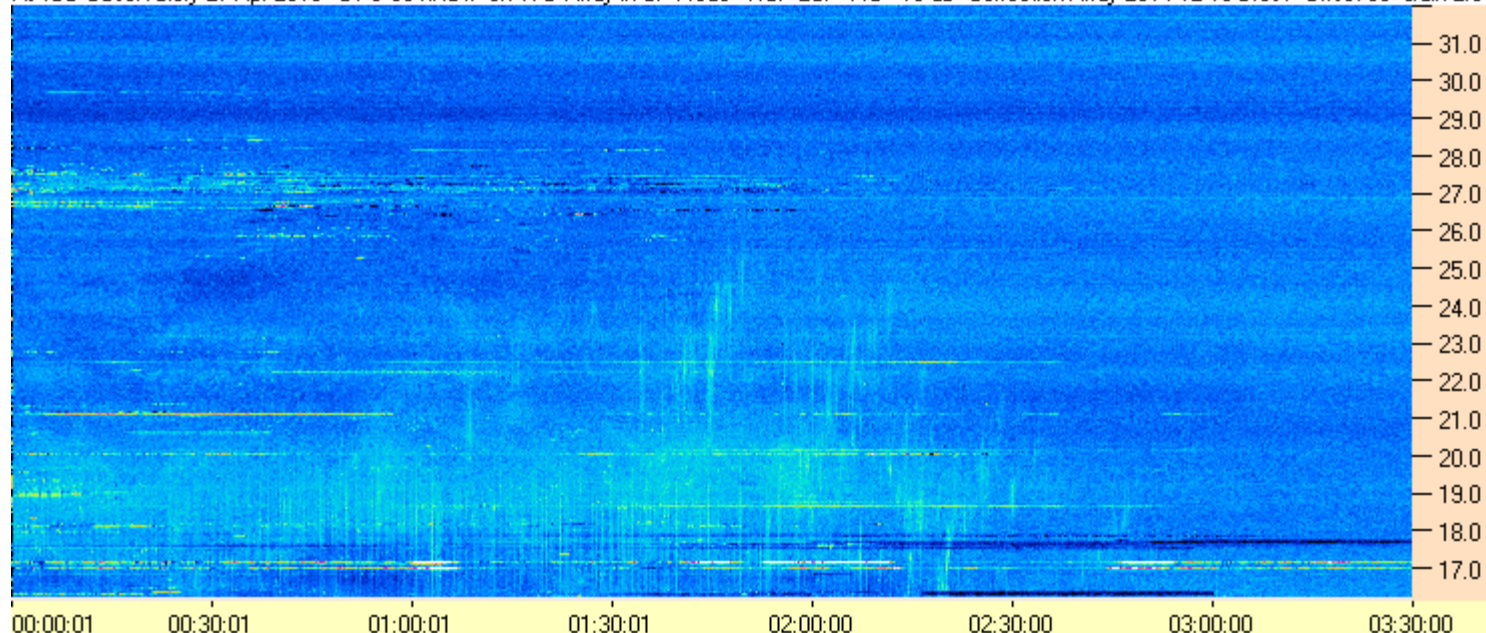
