RCP dominant L bursting 0154-0313 UTC from 16 to 23 MHz, negative drift emission envelopes.

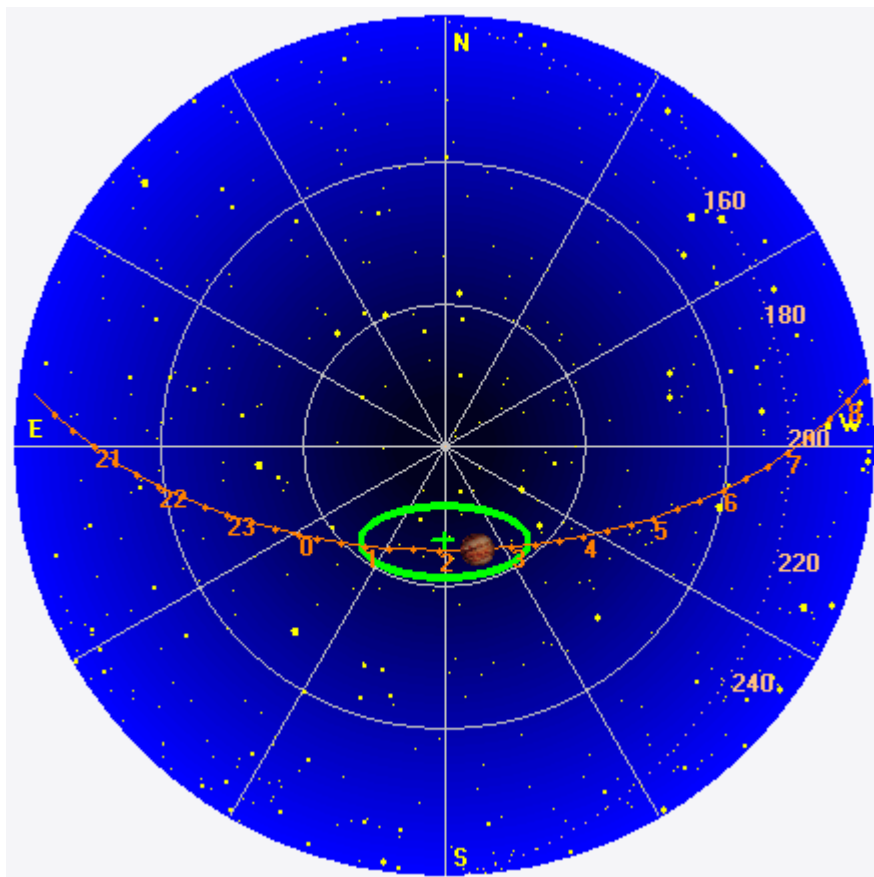
Jupiter was -4° to $+16^\circ$ off axis.

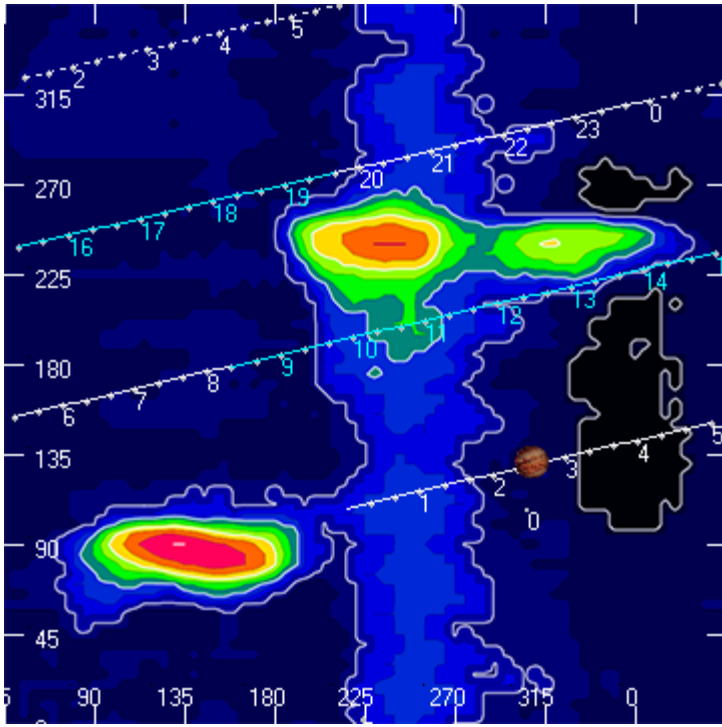
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 125° .

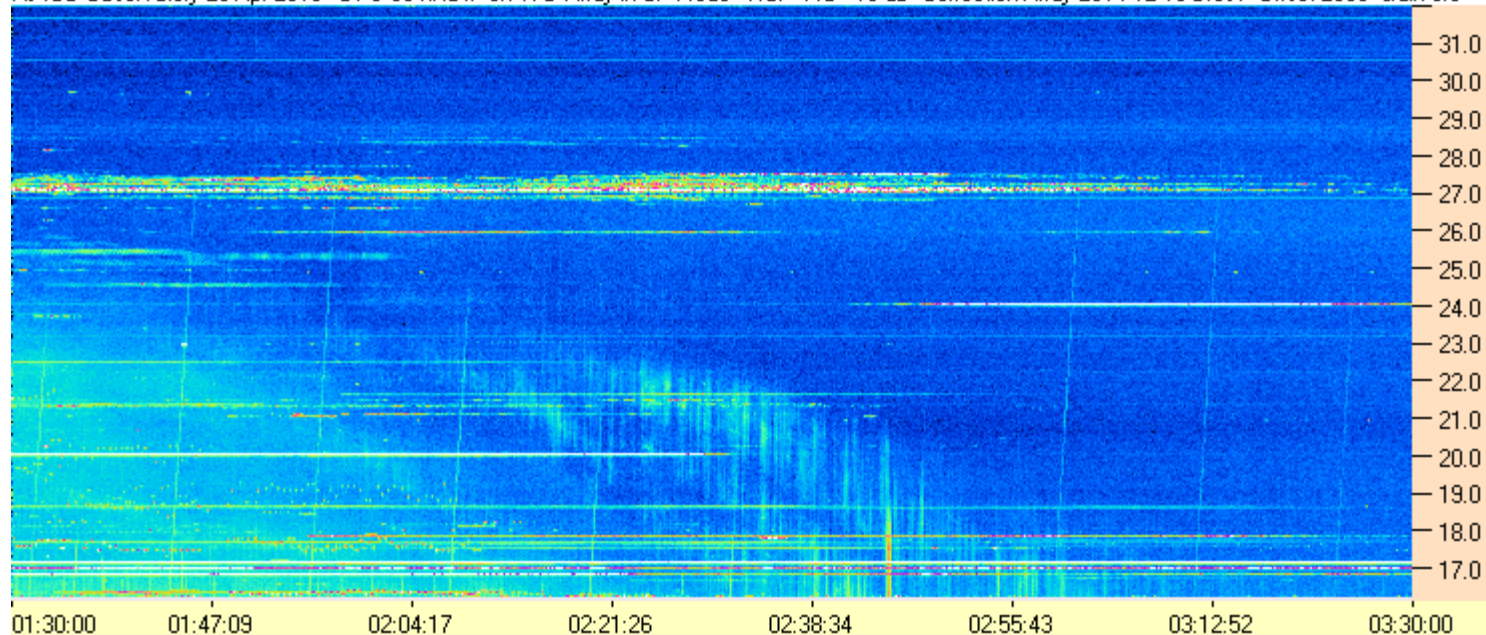

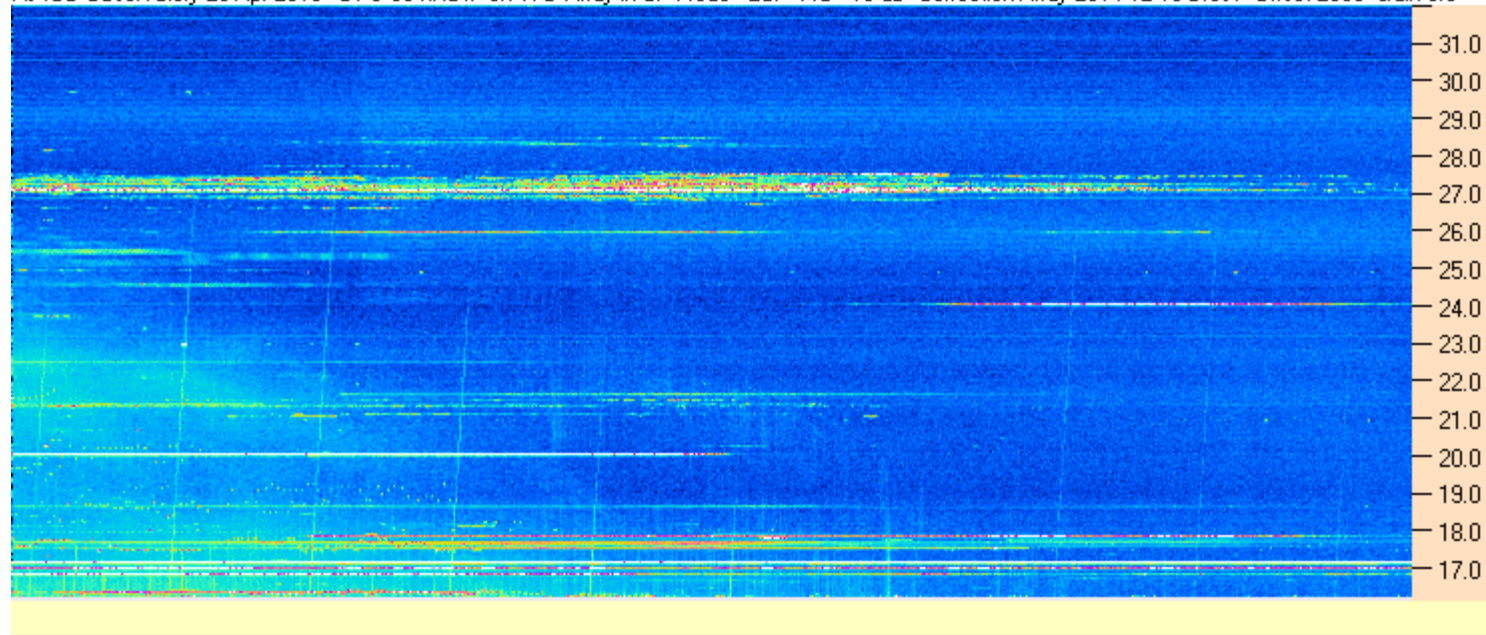




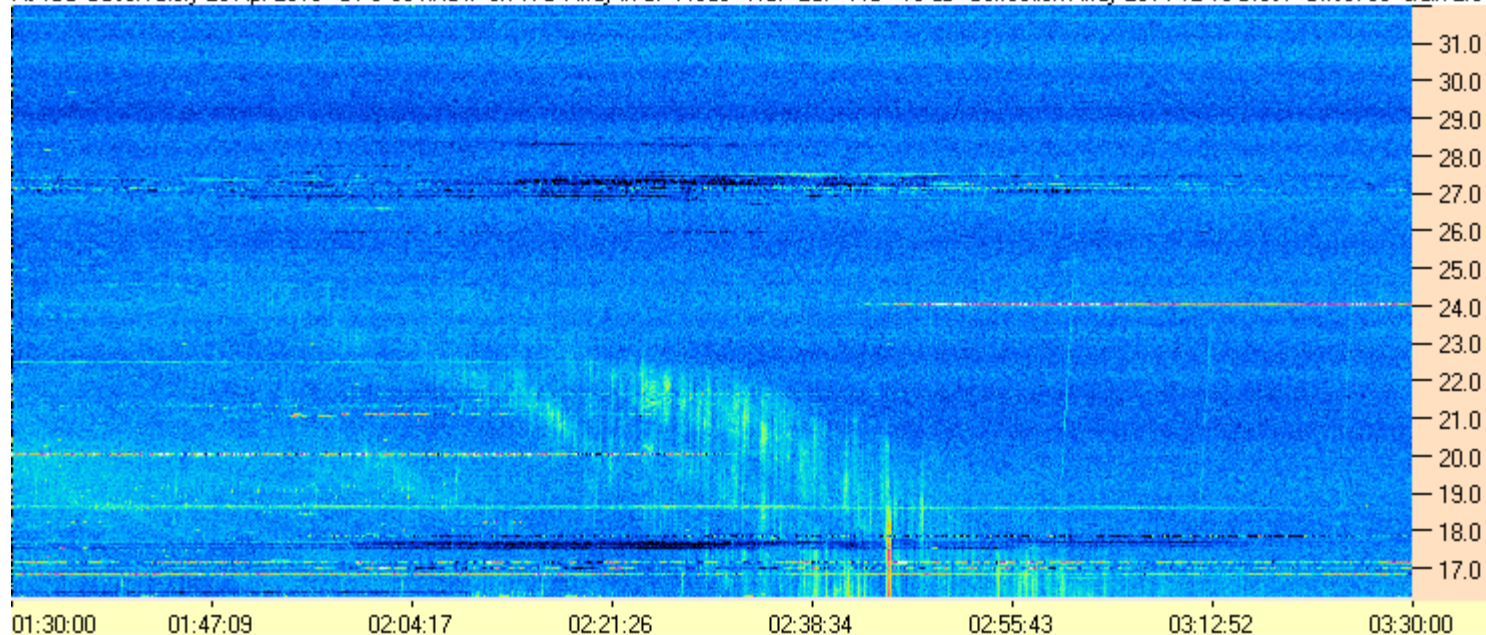
