RCP dominant L bursting 0204-0239 UTC from 16 to 25 MHz, negative drift emission envelopes.

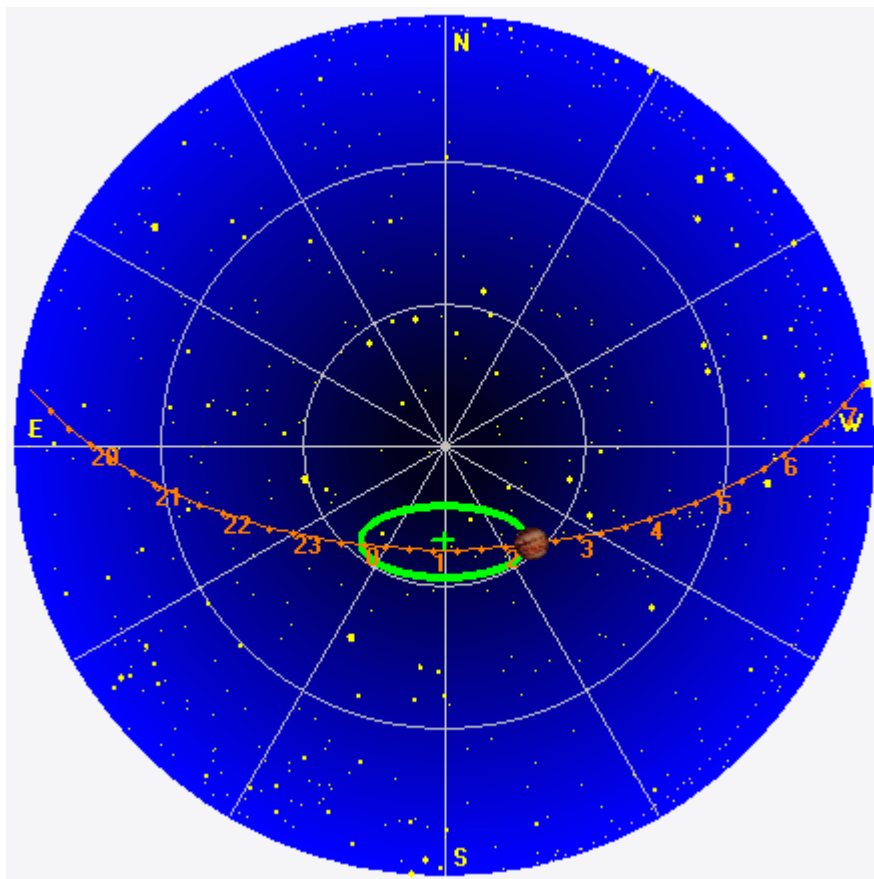
Jupiter was $+13^\circ$ to $+22^\circ$ off axis.

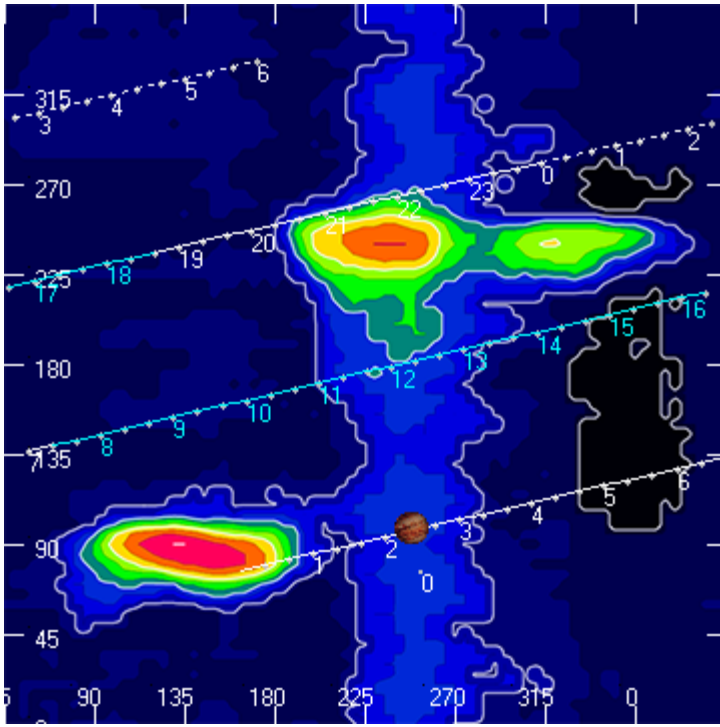
Jupiter was trailing the Sun by 112° .

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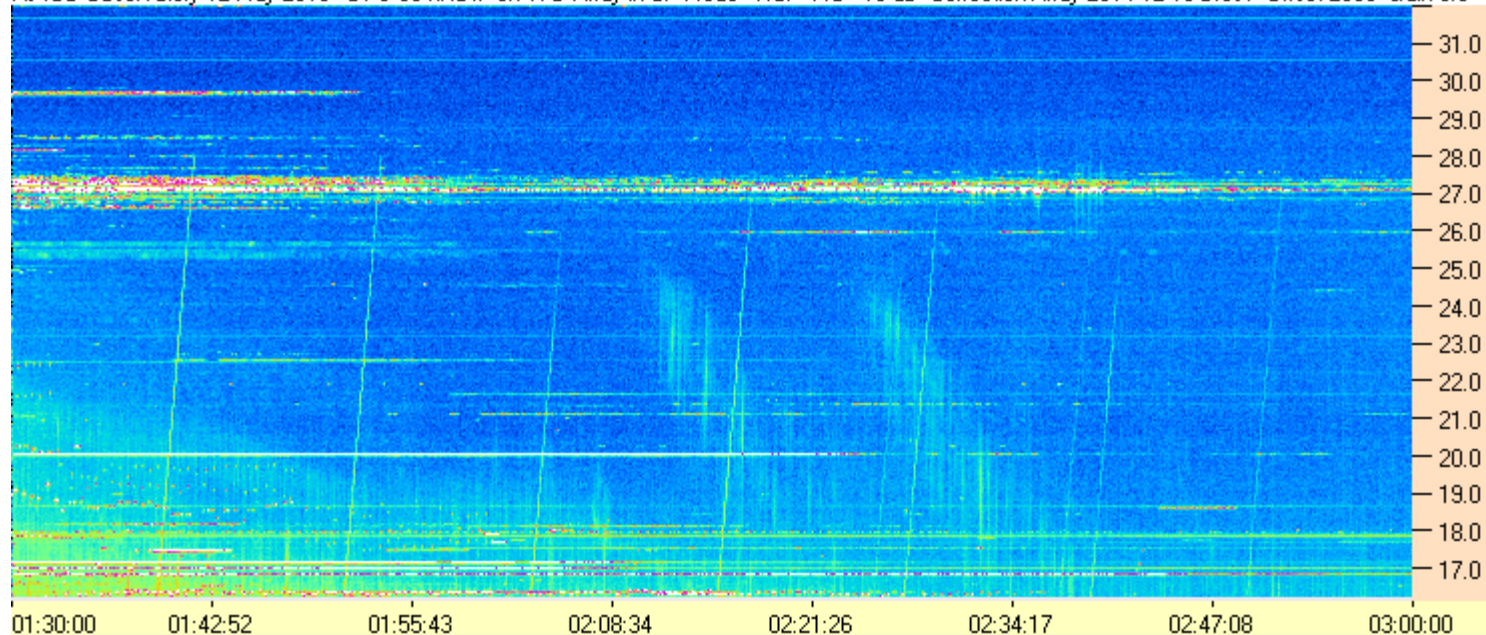

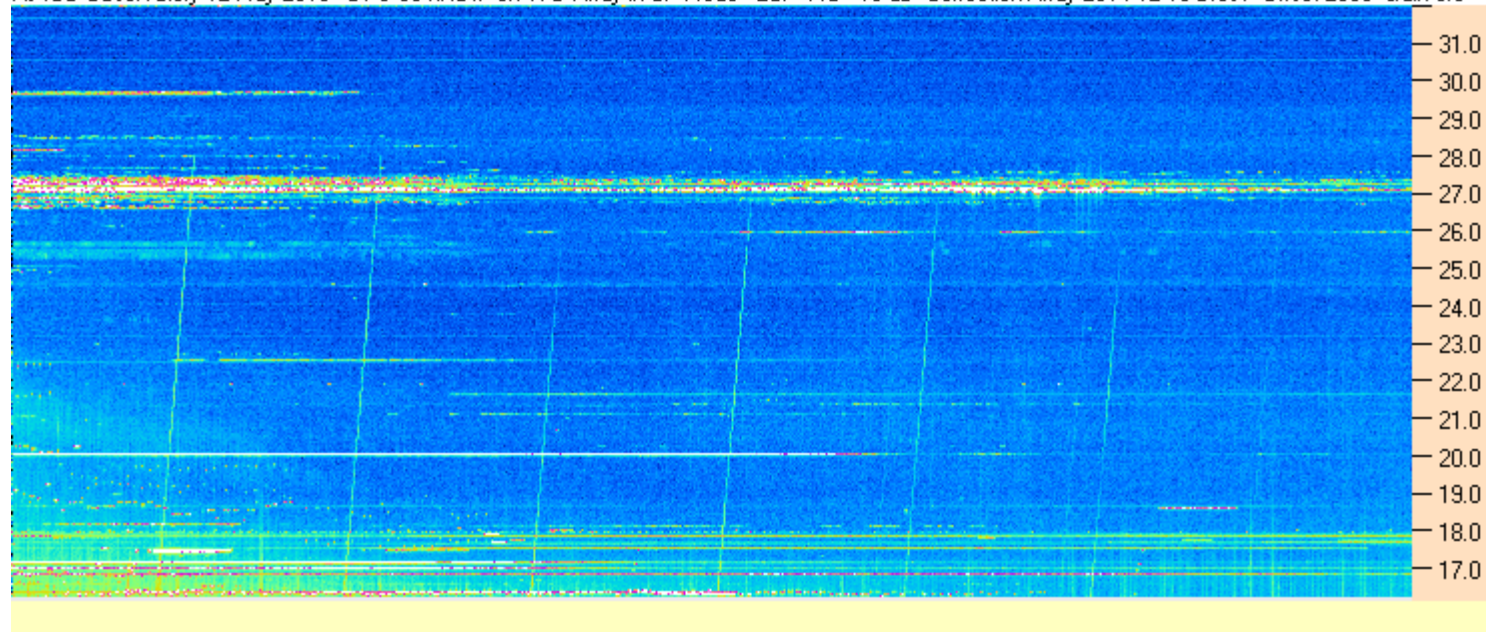




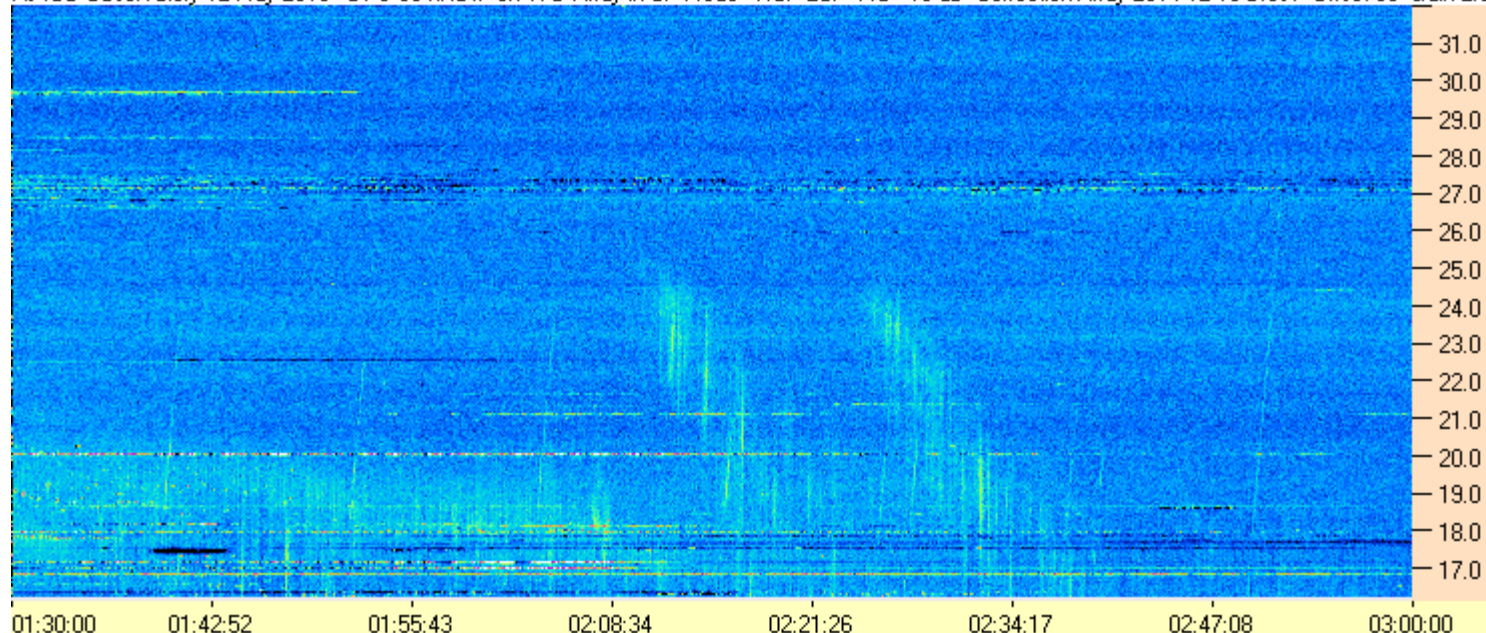
