

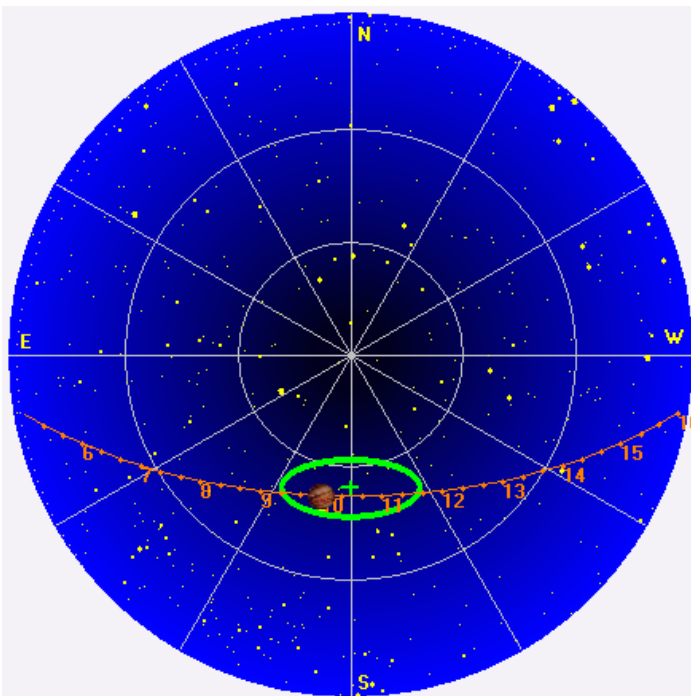
Some Io-D.

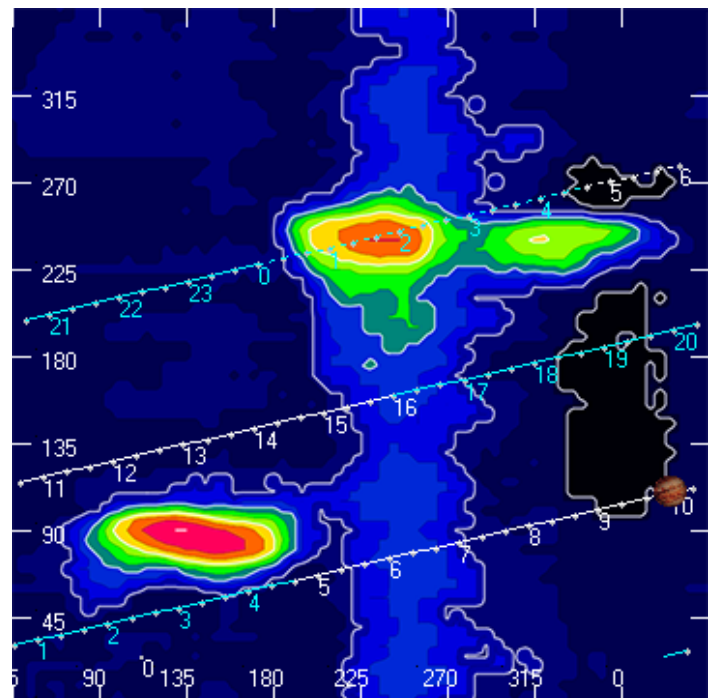
Jupiter was -19° to $+0^\circ$ off axis.

Jupiter's location at midpoint of observed emission (1001 UTC)

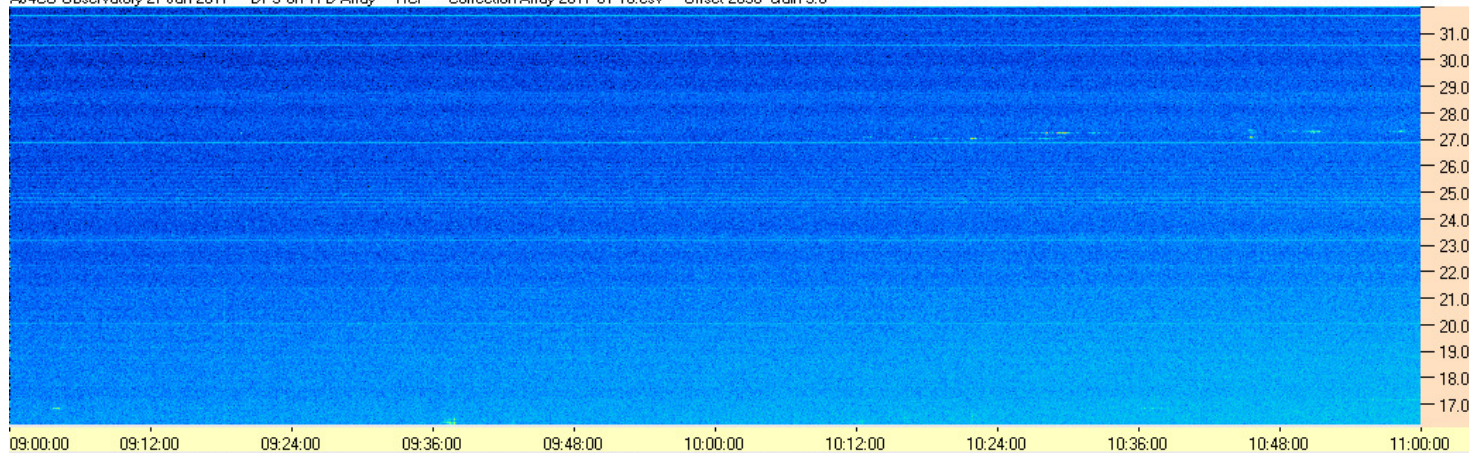


Sky map with array HPBW in green.

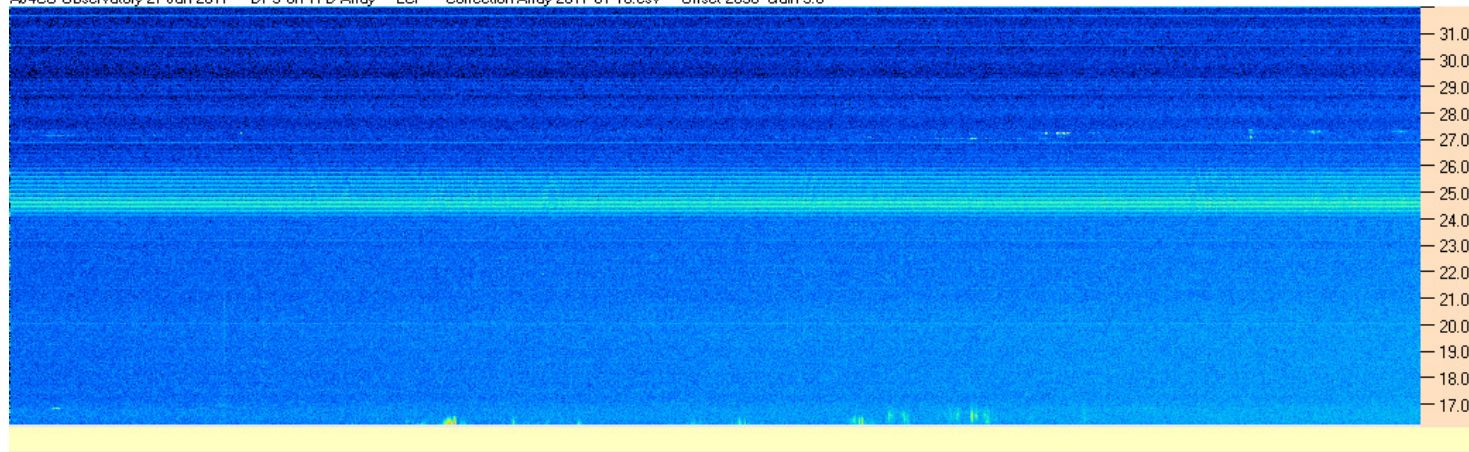


CML-Io phase plane.

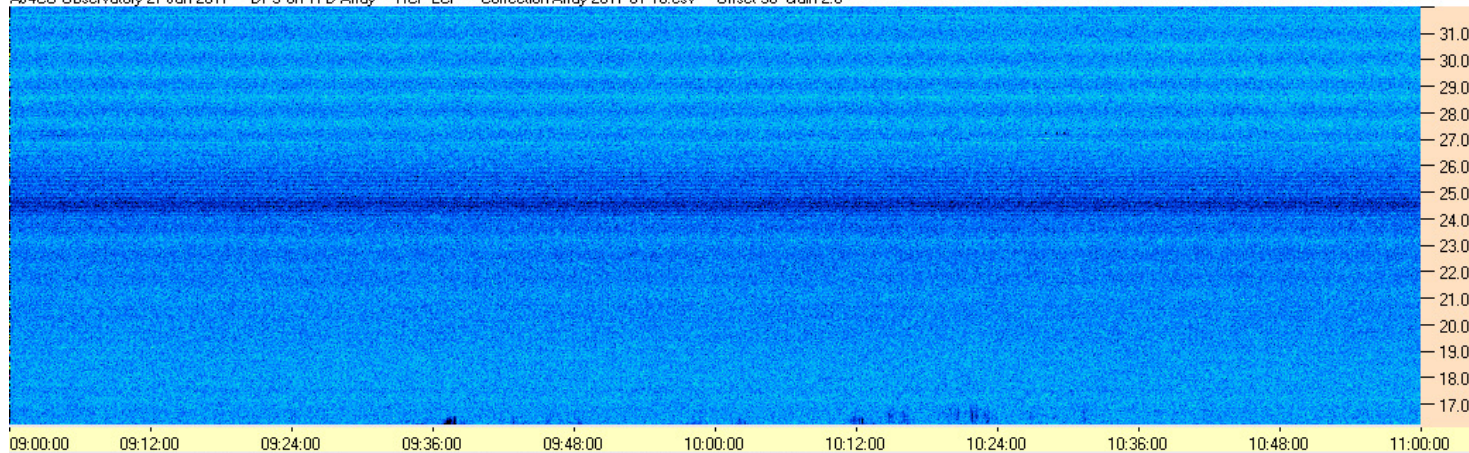
